

Maths

Our maths this term will cover the following units:

- Number 10 to 100
- Calculations within 20
- Addition and Subtraction
- Multiplication

We will continue to develop the children's arithmetic skills and start to look at the 2-, 5- and 10-times tables.

Our lessons will be multi-sensory using practical materials to support our learning.

Grammar, Punctuation & Spellings

This term we will be looking at:

- Full stops and capital letters
- Word classes (adjectives/nouns/verbs)
- Ouestions and statements

We will continue to recap and secure our phonics knowledge. We will also be moving onto different spelling rules.



Writing

Our writing this term will include:

- Poetry list poems, winter poem
- Character descriptions Roald Dahl Day
- Setting descriptions Titanic
- Letters from Titanic passengers and to Santa
- Instructions making gingerbread cookies
- Whole class, group and individual reading and comprehension.
- Handwriting





We will be using our topics as a stimulus when creating these art and DT projects:

- A view from the porthole of the Titanic
- Studying art from different cultures and times
- Experimenting with different media including paint and pastels.

Geography

As part of our Autumn topic 'Wonderful World' we will be:



- Using maps, atlases and globes
- Studying the United Kingdom and its countries
- Identifying the world's continents and oceans
- Understanding how to use a compass
