Our maths this term will cover the following units:

- Multiplication
- Division
- Shape
- Addition and subtraction of two-digit numbers.
- Money

We will continue to work on the children's mental maths skills linked to addition, subtraction, and multiplication. By the end of Year 2, the expectation is that children should be confident in the 2-, 5- and 10- times tables and corresponding division facts.

Grammar, Punctuation & Spellings


This term we will be looking at:

- Using co-ordinating conjunctions to extend sentences: or; and; but.
- · Regular and irregular past tense verbs.
- Expanded noun phrases.

We will continue to recap and secure our phonics knowledge as well as moving onto different spelling rules.

This term we will continue with whole class, group and individual reading with an adult, including whole class guided reading lessons. Our reading book this term will be:

Our writing this term will include:

- Posters persuasive posters to excite the reader.

- Writing a non-chronological report on a chosen animal.
- Poetry studying and writing animal themed poems.
- Daily handwriting activities.

- Using different media including varying pencil hardness and charcoal.
