

Maths

Our maths this term will

cover the following unit:

- Place Value up to 1.000
- Measurement using metres; cms; mms and converting between the different units
- Measuring mass
- Measuring volume
- Measuring capacity

We will begin with a History topic – The Egyptians where we will look at the Ancient Civilisation, focusing on everything we can discover about them through studying the tombs.

In Geography we will study the different natural disasters such as Earthquakes; volcanoes; tsunamis and the devastation these natural phenomena can cause.

History and Geography

Reading

Our reading books will be Egyptian Cinderella; followed by a selection of fairy stories and Anthony Browne books.

Our class book will be The Time travelling cat and the Egyptian goddess.

If we could ask that the children read daily at home please and make a note of this in their reading records. Please ensure they bring in their reading wallets on a daily basis as well.



Writing

Our writing this term will include:

- Adventure writing using Egyptian Cinderella – comparison of this version with the more traditional fairy tale
- Instruction writing How to make an Egyptian mummy
- Diary entry as Howard Carter discovering Tutankhamun's tomb
- Turning fairy stories into drama pieces
- A study of different Anthony Browne books
- Structured and shape Christmas poetry

OUR TOPICS: The Egyptians followed by Extreme Earth



Based on our Egyptian topic we will make clay masks.

In Art we will be using the topic Autumn to draw both in pencils and colour before then printing and painting using items from the natural world.

We will then do some sewing closer to Christmas where we will design and then create our own Christmas items.

In French we will start with a short unit, learning about colours, numbers

and greetings before moving on to all about me.

In RE we will be studying the religion Islam.



Science



Our first Science topic focusses on nutrition and movement – looking at the skeleton of humans and other animals and muscles. We will then move on to rocks to tie in with our Extreme Earth topic where we will look at fossils and soils as well as different rocks types.

Computing: Computing this term will cover Computing systems and networks and then Creating media – stop-frame animation

PSHE: PSHE will begin with a short unit on different emotions, linked to our zones of regulation, allowing children to work on identifying when they are in the different zones and thinking of tools to support them when they are not in the green zone.
