



## Maths

Our maths this term will cover the following units:

- Finishing place value up to 1,000
- Mental addition and subtraction
- Formal addition
- 2, 4 and 8 times tables
- Column subtraction

Our History and Geography topics are linked in the first half term. We are looking at land use in Geography and a local history study of Henham in History. Both of these will involve us looking at maps to see how land use has changed over the years; sketch maps to show land use currently and take a walk around Henham to see what it looks like now but also to see what evidence we can find about how Henham used to be 100 years ago.
