Invitation to review an Online Public Exhibition relating to the proposed new build accommodation at Henham & Ugley Primary School.

Essex County Council (ECC), as the Education Authority, proposes to provide a new single-classroom building to replace existing temporary accommodation. The new building will also include associated toilet area and storage facilities. The ECC Project Design Team has been working with Henham & Ugley Primary School to develop a proposal that would meet the school's educational need and that fits well on the school site.
