<u>Lateral Flow Test (LFT):</u> We are scheduled for a delivery of Lateral Flow Devices (LFD) on Tuesday 26th January, ready for staff in school to be tested twice weekly from Wednesday 27th January. Primary aged children will not be tested, under direction from the Government. Staff will self-administer the test on a Wednesday evening and a Saturday morning and inform me of the results on those days, whether negative or positive.

If a result from the LFT comes back as positive, the member of staff and anyone that has been in direct contact, would then have to self-isolate while the member of staff has a confirmatory Polymerase Chain Reaction test (PCR test). If the result of this test is positive, PHE will confirm the details of self-isolation for those that have been in direct contact and I will advise parents accordingly.

If the result of the PCR test is negative, again PHE will confirm any measures required and I will update you.

For Key Worker bubbles this means:

- If a member of staff tests positive on a Wednesday, I will have to close the Key Worker bubble that the staff member is in, on the Thursday. You will get this advice on a Wednesday evening, along with next steps.
- If a member of staff tests positive on a Saturday morning, I will contact you on the Saturday afternoon to confirm closure of the bubble, from Monday along with next steps.

Please do contact me if you need any further clarification of the above, I know it's a lot to take in!
