Dear parents/ carers,

<u>Parent Consultations, Wednesday 3rd and Thursday 4th March</u>: Many of you have already signed up via Scopay, and the class teachers will be in contact directly with you to arrange the Teams or Zoom calls at the beginning of next week.

<u>Breakfast and After School Club:</u> In line with the reopening, I am delighted to confirm that our wrap around provision will resume on the 8th March. The booking process remains the same via Scopay. If you need any support with this, please do contact Mrs Hipperson or Mrs Nicholls in the office, who will be happy to assist.

On a staffing note, Mrs Carter our Year 6 teacher and Deputy Head, will be leaving us on the 30th April; taking a break from teaching with a view to seek out new roles in the future.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank Mrs Carter for her hard work and commitment to the children and their families during the last four years. We all wish her much happiness for the future.

As ever, my priority is the children, to ensure they have a wonderful final term at Henham, and I have secured an experienced year 6 teacher, Mr. David Jackson, to support the children through to the end of the summer term in readiness for their transition to secondary school. Mr. Jackson will be in school before Mrs Carter leaves to ensure a smooth handover for the children.
