Maths

This term we will continue with our mastering number programme where the children will explore numbers in depth. We will be matching numbers to quantities and comparing numbers. This will lead on to exploring adding numbers together to find a total! We will also be exploring shape and measurement though play throughout the term.

Fine Motor skills and writing

This term we will continue to work on strengthening those little fingers for writing! The children will also begin their diaries! We will be writing, drawing and talking about all of the things that we get up to at the weekend and all of the things that are special to us! We will concentrate on writing simple CVC words to begin with, labelling pictures and items in our writing.


