



Maths

This term we will continue with our mastering number programme where the children will explore numbers in depth.

We will also explore measurement, weight, money and problem solving. The children will continue to master number bonds to 10 and counting beyond 20. All of our maths activities are based around play experiences so the children have a chance to really explore the mathematical concepts and master them.



Jolly Phonics

Phonics

We will continue to work our way through the jolly phonic programme. We will cover all of the sounds again. We will also focus on learning and practising high frequency words and common exception words. The children will continue with their word and sound walls. Keep up the reading at home – a little and often makes all the difference!

Fine Motor skills and writing

This term we will focus on writing words using phonic knowledge as independently as possible. We will also focus on writing sentences and captions. We will continue with our diaries. We will also be looking at writing instructions using descriptive language and 'bossy' words.

We will continue with or work in developing hand strength for stamina in writing and letter formation.



Expressive art and design

This term we will be junk modelling to show off our design skills. We will create maps of the London underground, kites and boats!

We will continue to learn new songs and using Charanga we will be experimenting with instruments to accompany our singing!



Knowledge and understanding of the world.

During the first half of this term we will be focussing modes of transport from the past. We will look at transport around the world and road safety.

We will of course also be doing lots of activities around the Royal Family and the Coronation!

In the second half of this term we will focus on the natural world and the seaside.

'Ticket to Ride' moving on to 'Fun at the seaside'.


Here is a snapshot of our learning this term!
