

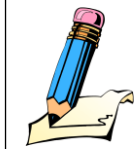


## Maths

Our maths this term will cover the following units:

- Fractions
- Division/Multiplication
- Shape
- Time
- Money
- Measure

We will continue to work on the children's mental maths skills linked to addition, subtraction, and multiplication. By the end of Year 2, the expectation is that children should be confident in the 2-, 5- and 10- times tables and corresponding division facts.



## Writing

Our writing this term will include:

- Descriptive writing about dragons
- Adventure stories.
- Writing a non-chronological report on a mythical creature.
- Newspaper articles
- Instructions on how to build a sandcastle
- Recounts of days out
- Daily handwriting activities.

## ART



We will be using our topics as a stimulus when creating these art and DT projects:

- Sketching flowers
- Sculpting mystical beasts
- Printing using carbon paper
- Baking scones for the coronation

## History



As part of our history topic we will be:

- Learning about the changes in how we communicate.
- Discuss the lives of significant individuals of the past.

After half term, we will continue to develop our Geography skills in identifying parts of the UK, weather patterns and human/physical

## Grammar, Punctuation & Spellings

This term we will be looking at:

- Identifying word classes and using them correctly in our writing
- Using the correct punctuation in sentences.
- Developing varied sentence structures

We will continue to recap and secure our phonics knowledge as well as learning different spelling rules.

## Reading

This term we will continue with whole class, group and individual reading with an adult, including whole class guided reading lessons. Our reading book this term will be:

**Computing** This term, the children will be looking at representing data in pictograms and creating music.
