

## Maths

Our maths this term will

cover the following units:

- Column addition and column subtraction
- Unit and non-unit fractions
- Right angles and turns
- Parallel and perpendicular lines

We will be continuing with our History of Henham topic – comparing Henham now to what it was like 100 years ago.

We will also be completing a unit on the Stone Age to the Iron Age.

We will look at what life was like during the times of Stone Age and the Iron Age; how life changed from the Stone Age to the Iron Age

Science
